WHEREAS, hand count elections increase resilience against external threats such as meddling or interference;

WHEREAS, thorough audits and transparent reporting processes verify and validate election results, maintaining public trust in the integrity of the electoral process;

WHEREAS, collaboration with election officials, community leaders, and stakeholders is necessary to design and implement transparent and secure hand count election systems that reflect the specific needs and concerns of Alaskan communities;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Alaskans:

Support legislation mandating that all elections in Alaska are conducted securely and by lawful hand count to address concerns about corruption, safeguard the integrity of the electoral process, and uphold the principles of transparency, accountability, and equal access to voting.
